Rodney gave updates on a number of subjects.

Scott shared details of an upcoming meteor shower which will occur on early on May 24, with the peak being from 2:00 - 3:00 am. The shower will be from a debris field from a comet, and is expected to generate 200 - 300 shooting stars per hour.

Meteorite Presentation – Chuck Spann

Chuck gave a presentation of some of his meteorites. He had two large meteorites, and showed the difference in meteorites "as found", and after they had been cleaned. He also shared a cross-section slab of a meteorite that showed the crystal structure.

As part of his presentation, Chuck showed a knife that had been made from 2 meteorites – one forming the blade and another forming the handle. He expects that smaller knives and letter openers will be available for sale at Green Back StarQuest.

Chuck also gave a brief overview and shared some features of Canyon Diablo.
